Portable Electronic Device Usage Contract 2017-2018

A 'portable electronic device" (PED) is defined as any device that can transmit or receive data (ie. cellphones, smartphones, tablets, gaming systems & laptops).

The **Sunday School Policy** on PEDs is designed to ensure that the use of these devices does not interfere with teaching and learning during the school day.

Maintaining integrity of the learning environment is top priority.

- Students will be permitted to have PEDs in their possession throughout the school day. However, PED use is **not** permitted **at any time** during the school day.
- Students **MUST have their PEDs turned off during school hours.**
- Student PEDs ringing in class will result in confiscation of the PED and disciplinary action.
- Should confiscation occur, the PED will only be returned when retrieved by a parent or guardian.
- School and its staff are in no way responsible for any damage, lost or stolen PEDs while on school grounds.
- The school is not obligated to investigate the loss or damage of any PED.
